The Wheatland Town Council held their regular meeting on June 12, 2017 in the Council Chambers. Vouchers and payroll in the amount of \$969,767.44 were approved for payment.

The next meeting will be **July 10, 2017** in Council Chambers at 7:00 p.m.

Business at a glance included:

- The town received several thank you notes and comments about how nice the cemetery looked for Memorial Day, and commending staff working in the main office on providing such good service.
 - The Council waived building permits and water tap fees for the Platte County Resource District. Brady Irvine represented the district.
 - Ordinance 808, Wheatland Historic Preservation Commission, passed on third reading. Ordinance 809, Recodification of Ordinances, passed on third reading.
 - Ordinance 810, Rezone Lots 41 and 42 of the Gunter addition, approved on second reading.
 - Ordinance 811, allowing temporary travel trail camping in Conservancy Zoning District, specifically Lewis Park and the Fairgrounds, effective August 19-22, 2017 only. Passed on first reading.
 - Banner Health Ambulance. An amendment to the agreement was approved.
 - Miniature Golf Course. Tom Bramlet was on hand to update the council on planning meetings held for the course. It is anticipated the course will be open Memorial Day, 2018.
 - Murals. Helen Rutz of the Platte County Art Guild thanked the council for their support of each of the 12 murals in town. She said they are finishing up work on the newest mural on the Marker Building that will depict the old Wheatland Roller Mill.
- A special meeting was held June 19th . Representatives from Fire District F, and the VFD were on hand.
- Ordinance 810 was approved on third and final reading.
 - Ordinance 811 passed on second reading. Third reading will be heard July 10.
 - Budget was amended as approved.
 - Five citizens were appointed to the Wheatland Historic Preservation Commission board.
 - A permit was approved to allow the fireworks stand to be open from June 22 through July 4.

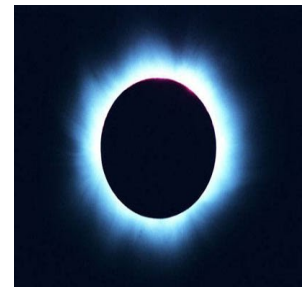
