

ORDINANCE NO. 792

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING ELECTRICAL SERVICES FOR THE TOWN OF WHEATLAND

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF WHEATLAND, WYOMING:

Section 1:

The Town of Wheatland provides the following electrical services:

- Residential
- Residential (All Electric)
- Commercial
- Large Commercial
- Security/Yard Light

Section 2:

The above services are defined as follows:

Residential:

Electrical services for all properties that are used exclusively for living purposes and their outbuildings, with exception to outbuildings or homes being used for business purposes which are master metered, have a special use permit, or licensed by any government entity.

Residential (All Electric Heat):

Electrical services provided for a property, defined above, in which the primary source of heat for the residence is electricity.

Commercial:

Electrical services for non-residential property and master metered property in which the property is used for providing a business or service. This shall include an electrical service provided to a residential property that provides business or services.

- Master Metered:
 - A method of metering the use of electricity of multiple customers metered cumulatively on one meter.
 - *Example, an apartment building on master metering would receive one bill for all apartments measured through one meter.*

Large Commercial:

An electrical service for non-residential or master metered properties which require greater than 200 Amperes of service and the property provides business or services.

Security/Yard Lights:

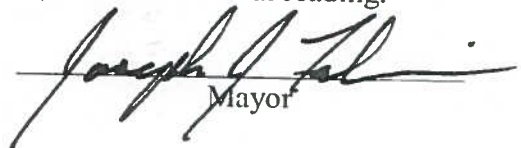
Security light mounted on a pole supplied and maintained by the Town of Wheatland as a dawn to dusk service.

This ordinance shall become effective the 1st day of October, 2015.
