



STREET CUT PERMIT APPLICATION

Any person who undertakes any work which will require cutting, breaking, or otherwise cause damage to a public street (right of way) within the Town of Wheatland must obtain a street cut permit prior to beginning the work.

Any licensed contractor who undertakes any excavation requiring a street cut within the limits of the Town of Wheatland must restore the excavation site or reimburse the town for all work performed by the Town of Wheatland in restoring the street to its original condition.

Attached to the permit shall be a scaled drawing of the location showing significant features within 100ft, and an estimated depth of the excavation.

The permittee, after completing excavation and performing all necessary repairs, shall restore the excavation site to its original condition and provide compaction test results where required by the town engineer and/or town building inspector. Such repairs shall be inspected by either the Town engineer or the town building inspector.

The contractor shall be responsible for maintaining all street cuts in such a manner as to avoid a hazard to traffic and a nuisance to residents until permanently repaired. All damage caused directly or indirectly to the street surface or subsurface outside the pavement cut area shall be regarded as a part of the street cut and shall be the responsibility of the contractor causing such damage. All test holes, scars, etc., shall be repaired before the town acceptance is given. If the backfill settles at any time during the first year after acceptance, causing deformation in the pavement, the repair may be performed by the Town of Wheatland or a third party contractor at the behest of the town and the cost of the repair to the pavement shall be billed to the responsible contractor.

All cuts, excavations and repairs shall be done in accordance with the minimum standards for such repairs as prescribed by the Federal, State and Town of Wheatland codes. The Contractor shall meet all the requirements for barricading and traffic control as specified by the Town of Wheatland and adopted codes. All barricades used by the contractor shall be clearly marked to indicate the name and telephone number of the utility or licensed contractor responsible for the work being performed.
