The Wheatland Town Council held their regular meeting on May 8, 2017 in the Council Chambers. Vouchers and payroll in the amount of \$792,385.43 were approved for payment. The next meeting will be June 12, 2017 in Council Chambers at 7:00 p.m.

Business at a glance included:

- Roll-offs for green waste are now in place. Locations are on page two. Keith Geis is working on sponsorships (advertising) for the roll-offs. If you're interested contact him at 322-9215.
- **Alex Fernandez** was sworn in as the town's newest law enforcement officer.
- Proclamations were presented for National Tourism Week and Municipal Clerks Week.
- Merlin Hitt was introduced as the new Executive Director for Platte County Economic Development.
- The Miniature Golf Committee includes Tom Bramlet, chair, Bob Seidel, Blinky Byers, Dennis Fischer, Steve Pollock and Jeff Brown.
- Ordinance 808, to create a Wheatland Historic Preservation Commission, was passed on second reading with minor changes. Third reading will be held on June 12th.
- Ordinance 809, adopting the recodification of Town ordinances was also approved on second reading. Third reading will be held on June 12th.
- Addendum to GDA Engineers regarding airport negotiations.
- Contract of Sale for James and Victoria Taylor regarding airport.
- A Resolution was passed to amend the 2016-2017 budget by \$100,000 to balance the sanitation fund.
- A donation to Wheatland Middle School students attending the National History Day competition in June was approved.
- The Town will be a Gold Sponsor for the 2017 Platte County Fair.
- Malt beverage permit approved for Marie Allison.
- Request from Rodney and Robin Nipper to divide Tract 3 of the Colt Track Acres subdivision was approved.
- Request from Larry and Mary Therriault to divide the 40-acre northern half of the Cascade subdivision was approved.
- Ordinance 810 created as a result of Sean and Ashley Harris' request to rezone their property. Ordinance passed on first reading.
- Water Replacement Fund established.
