The Town of Wheatland opened their new Solid Waste Transfer Station late August 2016, Landfill will be closing May 2018.

Solid Waste Transfer Station Dumping Hours:

Monday-Friday: 9:00AM – 4:00PM

Saturday: 9:00AM – 2:00PM

Method of Payments:

Cash, Checks, Credit and Debit Cards, a \$2.00 convenience fee will be assessed for Credit and Debit Card Payments. Charge accounts may be established.

Town of Wheatland will NO LONGER BE ACCEPTING shingles, concrete, asphalt, ashes, construction debris.

Town of Wheatland will RECYCLE at the solid waste transfer station and will ACCEPT paper/magazines, cardboard, plastic, aluminum cans and metal. NO GLASS.

Town of Wheatland ACCEPT white appliances such as refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners (**NOT IN TRASH CANS.**) Freon has to be removed by a certified licensed repairman, or a removal fee of \$40.00 paid in addition to the disposal fee will be added. All doors on refrigerators must be removed or there will be a \$10.00 fee. We will also accept all non-commercial tires less than 24.5", electric waste, lead acid batteries, trees, used oil, and antifreeze by individuals.

Town of Wheatland will have 8 Green Waste Roll Off Containers at different locations around town where you can put your grass clippings, leaves and small branches. **No black plastic bags.**

DO NOT put household garbage, hazardous waste, electronic waste, white goods or tired in the Green Waste Roll Off Containers. There will be fine up to \$750.00 for illegal dumping.
